The Holy Spirit In Action

The subject of gifts of the Spirit is one of the most misunderstood doctrines of scripture. When we say that God is our Father and that we are His children, we mean God has not only accepted us but that He has endued us with power to become the sons of God to represent Him in the world as He would represent Himself. As children of God, we are partakers of the supernatural and divine power that belongs to God. God has made full provision for the full manifestation of His power and life through His people.

Spiritual gifts in the believers are absolutely necessary if the church is to function properly and accomplish for God in the Earth what he has purposed in this age. They are necessary to God and man in carrying out the will of God as the members are necessary to the natural body.

Read: 2 Peter 1:4

Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Questions:

- 1. What are believers partakers of?
- 2. Why is this so important to understand?

Read: 1 Corinthians 12:12-26

- ¹² For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.
- ¹³ For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.
- ¹⁴ For the body is not one member, but many.
- ¹⁵ If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?
- ¹⁶ And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?
- ¹⁷ If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?
- ¹⁸ But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.
- ¹⁹ And if they were all one member, where were the body?
- ²⁰ But now are they many members, yet but one body.
- ²¹ And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.
- ²² Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary:
- ²³ And those members of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely parts have more abundant comeliness.

- ²⁴ For our comely parts have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that part which lacked.
- ²⁵ That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.
- ²⁶ And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.

Read: 1 Corinthians 12:4-7 King James Version

- ⁴ Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- ⁵ And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.
- ⁶ And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.
- ⁷But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

- 2. Who are the gifts a manifestation of? Explain!
- 3. Who are these gifts for?
- 4. What benefit will they bring.
